This event allowed families in the community and surrounding areas an opportunity to enjoy a *FREE* family night and learn how STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics) education relates to aviation

and the local area. Activities included fun, interactive, and educational STEM demonstrations/booths, free giveaways, a photo opportunity with Marine Corps flight gear and concluded with a showing of *Incredibles 2* on a giant screen.

ECAHF's mission is to celebrate the heritage of Marine aviation in Coastal Carolina as a lasting tribute to the evolving communities, both military and civilian, and extend that heritage, culture and knowledge to generations of Americans through experiences that entertain and educate. The event featured interactive activities and exhibits for all ages related to STEM: weather with a meteorologist onsite, engineering, flying a drone, Civil Air Patrol with a flight simulator, HAM Radio communication, ejection seats, flight equipment, use of robots to detect ordnance materials, fire and rescue, H46 Rescue Helicopter, and several others. 2019 Eastern Carolina Summer Elementary School Engineering Camp

July 15-19, 2019

Wow! What a great Summer Engineering Camp this year! Fifty-three rising fourth, fifth, and sixth grade students participated in STEM activities throughout the week. Students were divided into design teams led by local school teachers and Engineers from FRC-East. In their teams, students were given the challenge to individually design and build various devices related to aviation and engineering. Students learned engineering fundamentals by exploring various experiments related to aviation. Each design team was also assigned a youth volunteer to assist with the various activities.

On Monday, the camp kicked off with a visit from the Morehead Planetarium *Science on Your Street* Program. Students were introduced to the Physics of Flight and built miniature rovers.

The NASA Space Grant organization brought their award winning UNC Charlotte rocket building team. In addition, the Engineering Club from Campbell University visited and provided various hands-on activities with rockets and rovers for the students.

Thursday was "Lift-Off" Day. Students constructed Estes rockets and each team launched the rockets. Parents, community partners and ECAHF members attended a Camp Showcase on Friday. Students worked in groups and presented about their area of expertise to the audience. The week was a huge success. We cannot wait until next year!
